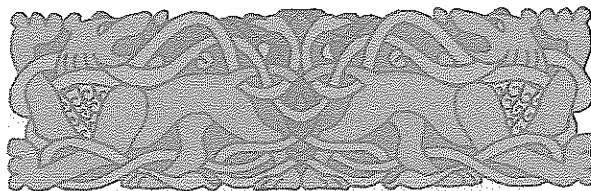

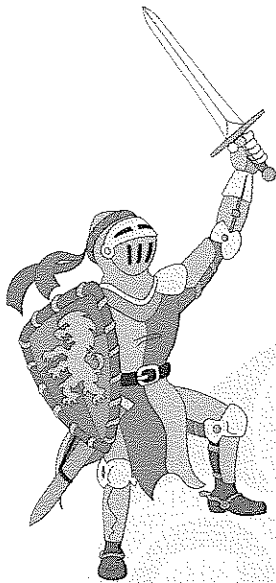

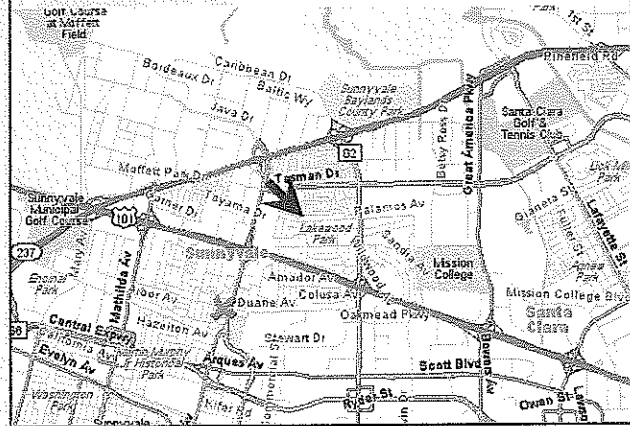


☞Lakewood Park Directions☞

from Points South:
 Take 101 N to Lawrence Expressway
 Turn right onto Lawrence Expressway
 getting immediately into the left lane*
 Turn left onto Lake Haven (first light)**
 Turn right onto Silver Lake (first right)
 The park is on the left hand side.
 We will meet at the Picnic Tables

From Points East:
 Take 237W to Lawrence Expressway
 Take the Lawrence exit (going back over 237)
 Turn right onto Lake Haven**

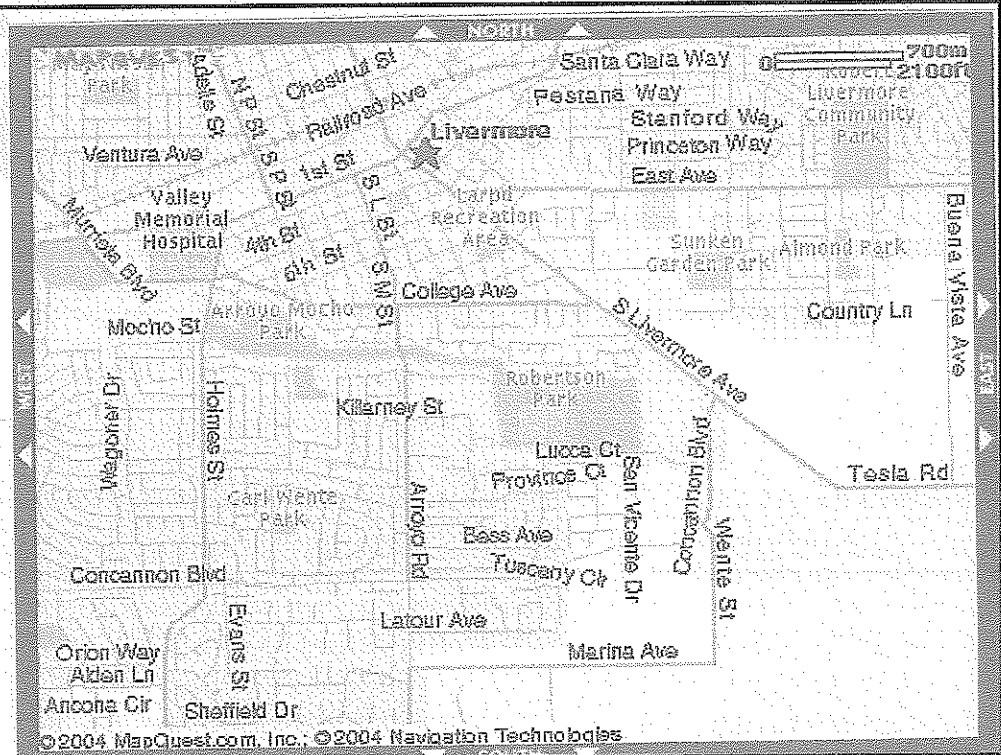
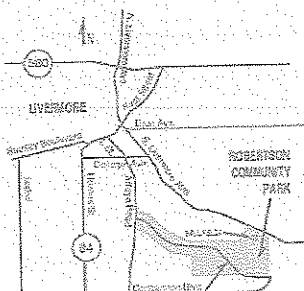
From Points North:
 Take 101S to Lawrence Expressway
 Turn left onto Lawrence Expressway
 getting immediately into the left lane*

Take I-580 to the North Livermore Avenue exit. Proceed South on Livermore Avenue. Turn right on First Street, left on L Street (which becomes Arroyo Road) and a final left on Robertson Park Road. The Fair is located at Robertson Community Park.

Robertson Community Park - A Special Use Park

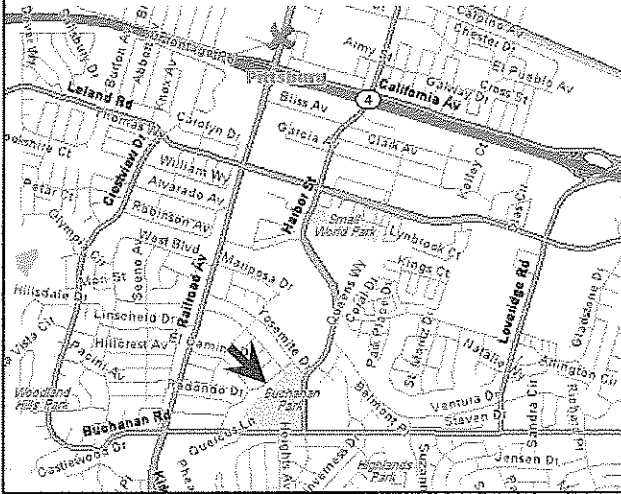

General Directions:

Take Highway 4 to Railroad Avenue. From 680 turn right on Railroad, from Antioch, turn left onto Railroad. Proceed down Railroad Avenue to Buchanan Road, turn left. Turn left on Harbor Street. The Park is on the corner of Buchanan & Harbor. We generally meet on the 'Yosemite Dr.' corner of the park.
