↳ Buchanan Park Directions ↻

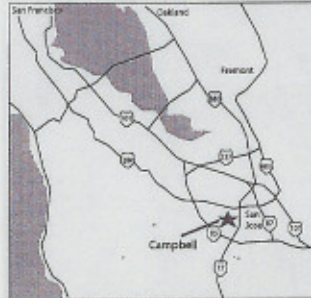
General Directions:

Take Highway 4 to Railroad Avenue. From 680 turn right on Railroad, from Antioch, turn left onto Railroad. Proceed down Railroad Avenue to Buchanan Road, turn left. Turn left on Harbor Street. The Park is on the corner of Buchanan & Harbor. We generally meet on the 'Yosemite Dr.' corner of the park.

Directions:

- From San Francisco:** Take 205 South toward San Jose, take Hwy 17 South toward Santa Cruz exit. The first exit will be Hamilton Avenue; go west (right). Turn left at the third traffic signal onto Winchester Boulevard. Turn right at the second traffic signal onto Campbell Avenue. Turn right at the next traffic signal and enter the Community Center parking lot.
- From the East Bay:** Take 880 South to the Hamilton Avenue. Go west (right) on Hamilton Avenue. Turn left at the third traffic signal onto Winchester Boulevard. Turn right at the second traffic signal onto Campbell Avenue. Turn right at the next traffic signal and enter the Community Center parking lot.
- From Santa Cruz:** Take Hwy 17 North toward San Jose. Take the Hamilton Avenue exit and turn west (left) onto Hamilton Avenue. Take Hamilton Avenue to Winchester Boulevard and turn left (south). Turn right at the second traffic signal onto Campbell Avenue. Turn right at the next traffic signal and enter the Community Center parking lot.
- From South 101:** Take 101 North to Hwy 85 North. Take Hwy 85 to Hwy 17 North. Take the Hamilton Avenue exit and turn west (left) onto Hamilton Avenue. Take Hamilton Avenue to Winchester Boulevard and turn left (south). Turn right at the second traffic signal onto Campbell Avenue. Turn right at the next traffic signal and enter the Community Center parking lot.

General Directions:

Take Interstate 680N to Highway 12. Turn right onto Highway 160.

The park is on Highway 160 a few miles south of the city of Rio Vista in Sacramento County. The park is located on the lower peninsular extension of Brannan Island, and is surrounded by the Sacramento River on the west, Three Mile Slough on the southeast, and Seven Mile Slough on the northeast. We will be in the Sacramento Group Site #5 & 6.

Take 580E (become 205) to 99S. Exit Maze Boulevard (becomes 9th Street), turn left onto 9th Street. Turn left at Yosemite Boulevard. Turn right onto Santa Cruz Avenue. Santa Cruz Avenue dead ends into Legion Park Drive.
