## Truckee Scottish Renaissance Faire

Please join us on our procession to the Truckee Scottish Renaissance Faire at Truckee River Regional Park on Saturday, September 15 and Sunday, September 16. (Setup for this event will take place between 2:00pm and 4:00pm on Friday, September 14th. This is St. Andrew's 4th appearance at this faire, which is produced by our own Sandy Horn (Lady Jean). The Truckee Renaissance Faire is set in or about the year 1562, at the height of the Renaissance as it influences politics and religion in Scotland, England, and France.

This is an apolitical faire, however, taking place in what could be any European country town celebrating Michaelmas, the harvest festival, with much eating and drinking, singing and general carousing. This is a full set up!

Camping will be available onsite for free. Showers will be available at the local area school. Please note that at an elevation of 6,000 ft. the temperatures can drop dramatically with the sunset and everyone should be prepared for chilly mornings and frost (if not snow), by outfitting themselves with boots, gloves, and capes/cloaks. Campers will want to be prepared for near freezing temperatures at night by bringing extra bedding.

## Directions to Truckee River Regional Park

### From Eastbound Interstate 80:

Exit #186 onto Donner Pass Rd toward Central Truckee — go 0.8 miles

At the end of Downtown Truckee there is a three-way stop at the railroad tracks; turn right across the tracks onto Brockway Road — go 0.4 miles

Truckee River Regional Park is on the left

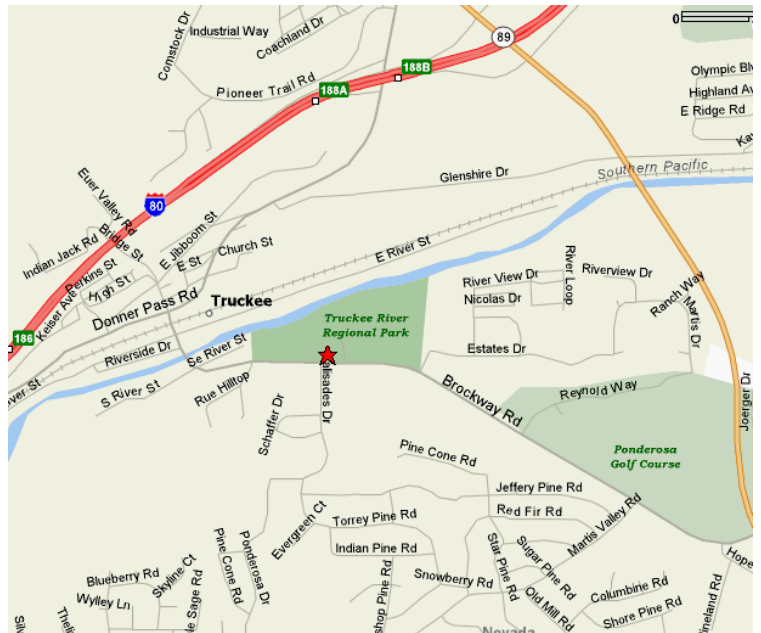
### From Westbound Interstate 80:

Take exit # 188/CA-267-CA-89 toward Lake Tahoe/Sierraville — go 0.4 miles

Turn right on Truckee Bypass (CA-89) go 0.2 miles

Turn Left to follow CA-89 go 0.3 miles  
CA-89 becomes Donner Pass Road; go 0.9 miles

At the three-way stop at Downtown Truckee turn left across the railroad tracks onto Brockway Road — go 0.4 miles and Truckee River Regional Park is on the left



## Directions to Calaveras County Fairgrounds

### From Stockton:

Take Highway 4 to Angels Camp; when you reach Angels Camp, make a right and follow Highway 49 to the fairgrounds a few miles out of town. Be sure to stay to the right (on Highway 49) when it splits from Highway 4 at the end of town.

### From Sacramento:

Take Highway 99 South to Liberty Road ( a little past Galt)

Take Liberty Road until it ends at Highway 88, turn right onto 88.

Follow Highway 88 until it ends at

Highway 12, and turn left on Highway 12.

Follow 12 until it merges with Highway 49 in San Andreas, then follow Highway 49 through San Andreas to Angels Camp.

The Fairgrounds are just past Angels Camp on Highway 49.
