Returning to this successful one-day event, we will again portray the Royal Court with a Partial Set Up of Her Majesty's Pavilion and the Highlander 12x12 Canopy. This is a lovely park in the heart of the City of Santa Cruz. There is no Actors' Camp on site. Some folks will be staying in RVs and tent camp sites at the Santa Cruz Ranch RV Park in Scotts Valley <http://santacruzranchrv.com> which is about 5 ½ miles from the event site. This is a partial set up, with Load Up at the Keep in Newman on Thursday September 30 at 6:00 PM, Set Up on Friday October 1 (time to be announced), and Unload Sunday October 3 (time to be announced). Household Notes are at 9:00 AM, with Guild notes at 9:30 AM Saturday. Gates open at 10:00 AM and close at 6:00 PM. Average temperatures are a high of 75 with a low of 50. You may want to check the weather forecast as the date nears for a more accurate prediction <http://www.nws.noaa.gov>. Using last year as a gauge, the wind picked up in the afternoon. In addition to our usual schedule, a Squiring Ceremony will be held for Lady Mary Katherine MacLeod. Her Majesty does hope you will be able to attend this event.
