Mary Stuart was born this day at Linlithgow to Marie de Guise and James V of Scotland. She was King James V's only legitimate child.

~ Mary Stuart Becomes Queen~ December 14, 1562

Mary's father, James V died on December 14, 1562 at Falkland Palace following the Battle of Solway Moss, leaving Mary as the heir to the throne. She was crowned the following September. Her mother Marie de Guise ruled as Regent until her death in June 1560. Mary then returned to Scotland from France and began her Progress throughout Her Realm.
