We will travel to England and the late 16th century as the Duke of Orkney's Entourage. The weekend will be eventful with the Squiring of Lady Gwendolyn Elliot, we will provide Queen Elizabeth with Haggis for her Saturday Repast and Roasted Chicken for her Sunday repast, and other scheduled gigs. Throughout the faire, participants will be focusing on educating the public about 16th century English money. You will be provided with 'cheat sheets' at morning notes, feel free to wager on various activities throughout the faire site, discuss costs of goods, essentially take and make opportunities to use period money as a topic of discussion and gigs. Kids will be participating in the Passport Program again this year; they will go from guild to guild to get their passports stamped. This program will be explained further at morning notes. The faire board also asks that we educate the patrons about the Dance Macabre. The premise of this group is to imitate death and convince Death that he has already visited us and to pass us by. We will be setting up HRM's pavilion as the Duke's pavilion. We will have two back rooms; one with water, Gatorade and ice and a place for you to store your personal food, and the second room for your other personal belongings. *Due to space restrictions there will be no viands table. Water, Gatorade and ice only will be provided. Bring your own food and take care of yourself. Remember to have period tableware (a pie tin works perfectly).* Load Up Thursday May 5 at 6PM, Set Up Friday May 6 time TBA, Unload Monday May 9 time TBA.
