We will once again portray the Court of Mary, Queen of Scots at this wonderful event. We will have a full weekend of activities and gigs in Court and the faire site. There is no Load Up for this event, as we will not unload from the Monterey Games. Set Up is on Friday July 15 and Unload Monday July 18 (times to be announced). Household Notes are at 9:00 AM, with Guild notes at 9:30 AM both days. Gates open at 10:00 AM, the faire closes at 6:00 PM on Saturday and 5:00 PM on Sunday. Promoters have again amped up publicity and coordination with local businesses and the Chamber of Commerce. This will be at the height of tourist season, vendors and guilds are signing up, and we expect the faire to be well attended by locals, and area tourists. *We are the focal point of this faire and we need you in attendance.* Many of you met Breshelle at Modesto Games; she will be portraying Queen Elizabeth while

we portray MQS and her Court. This will be a friendly interaction between monarchs and their subjects. Local hotels fill up fast and can be pricey, so if you plan on hoteling it, it is suggested you make your reservations sooner than later. Last year Lady Beaton had a nighttime encounter with Smokey. DIRECTIONS: From Fresno, take Hiway 168 East to Shaver Lake, the Community Center on the left. If you reach Dinky Creek Road on the right, you’ve gone a hair to far, if you reach the Lake you’ve gone too far. The Musick Creek Inn & Chalet is across the road from the Community Center/Library. Please be warned there are many “Tollhouse Road” crossroads as you travel, don’t be misled and turn off. Hiway 168 becomes Tollhouse Road. Search Engine Maps or your GPS may not know the way.
