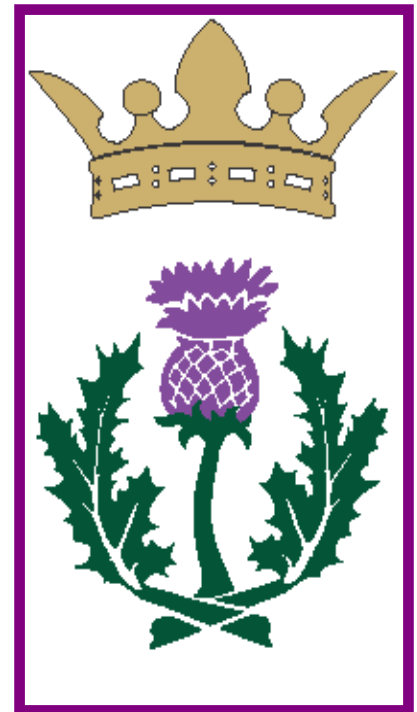

Volcano Christmas Walk - Dec 12

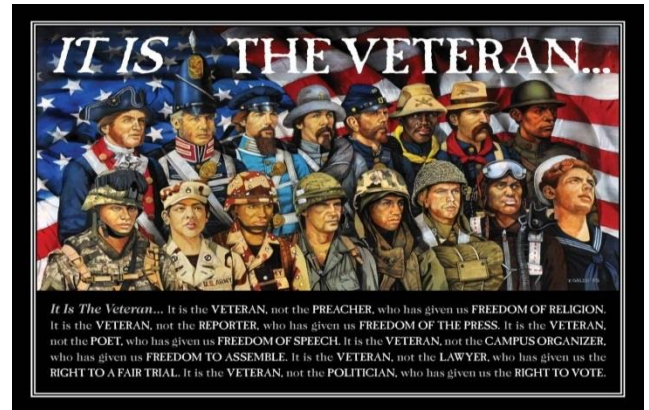

With Veteran's Day celebrated this month, we thank all our Veterans and their families for their selflessness and sacrifice. God Bless You!

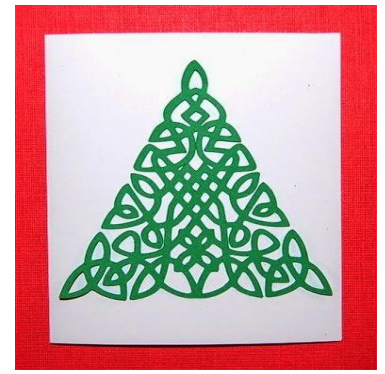
